ABOUT THE AUTHOR

Louis started writing soon after he was accepted at Brooklyn Technical High School, taking the bus every day from Queens. He and a friend were the two accepted from more than 600 student applications. The year was 1955. He enjoyed the engineering classes especially and actively wrote papers on the many facets of engineering, industrial manufacturing, and particularly mechanical drawing.

His late teenage years were marked by the family's several relocations between Portsmouth, NH, Marshalltown, Iowa, Central Islip, Long Island, in addition to his early years in East Elmhurst, Queens, where he attended P.S. 127 Elementary School.

Each change of address required a change of school, culminating in his graduation with a GED from Jamaica High School in Queens, NY.

His interest in printing began in Portsmouth where, at the age of 16, he worked as a stone-hand and press operator; his experience in typography blossomed, eventually becoming the foundation for a career in typography and graphic design. He was able to put his growing talent in writing and design to advantage working for commercial printers in New Hyde Park, LI, and later in Manhattan, New York.

In the early 70s he used his writing and graphic experience to form an advertising agency, working from a home office. Several years later he was invited to work at a local ad agency in Northport, Long Island as senior account manager.

He left the agency for a production position at a New York City brokerage firm. Later, in 1985, he formed a commercial print brokerage company serving local and Manhattan businesses, which continues to operate today.

He has designed hundreds of corporate identity materials, sales promotional collaterals and branding guidelines, including a trade display and video for a national client.

Recently, he has written and self-published several paperback journals under the imprint Quiet Creek Publishing, with themes including music, books, television and the movies.

Together with his wife, the couple co-wrote a memoir on the life of their Yorkshire Terrier, published in 2020, *Millie! A Love Story* and a follow-up book, *Millie! The Last Chapters*. **AMERICA!** is his seventh book.

He lives with his wife Roseanne, in Bradenton, Florida.
